

He Brought Him to Jesus
John 1:35-42
March 15, 2026

Discussion Questions - These are a conversation starter and guide, not a script.

1. John repeats his declaration, “**Behold the Lamb of God**” in v. 36. Why is the faithful, continual, and persistent proclamation of Christ crucified so powerful? See Romans 1:16-17. When we proclaim Christ crucified, what benefits are there for us as the proclaimers? What benefits are there for the people to whom we proclaim Christ crucified?

2. What was the point of Jesus’ question in v. 38? What were some of the wrong reasons that people followed Jesus? How did the men’s answer show that they wanted the right thing in following Jesus? If Jesus were to ask you this question, what would you say?

3. How does Jesus’ answer show that He was inviting them (and us) into His life? See John 14:23 and Revelation 3:20.

4. What was the first thing Andrew did after spending time with Jesus? Why is a personal invitation from a trusted person so powerful in bringing people to Christ? How can we be more like Andrew in inviting people to Jesus?

5. In Jesus’ first words to Peter, how does He acknowledge both who Peter *is* and foretell who Peter *will be*? How does Jesus do the same to us? What are some specific ways that Jesus has changed you, used you, and led you that you did not anticipate when you first believed in Him?
