Discussion Questions - These are a conversation starter and guide, not a script.

1. If you can remember, who was the first person who told you about the Lord? Who was the most influential person who told you about the Lord? What made this person so influential in your life?

2. What do we learn about being a faithful witness to the Lord from John the Baptist?

3. John the Baptist knew that **“he was not the light” (8)**. What are some subtle ways that we might start to believe and act as if we are “the light”?

4. Why is it such good news that Jesus is the *true* light? What does it mean that the true light gives light to *everyone* (v. 9)?

5. What does it mean that Jesus gave us **“the right”** to become children of God (v. 12)? What does it mean to **“believe in His name”**? What does it mean that we are **“born... of God”** (v. 13)? Why does John emphasize the ways we were *not* born (v. 13)?
