John 4:31-42

Discussion Questions - These are a conversation starter and guide, not a script.

1. What did Jesus mean when He said His food was to do God's will and finish His work (v. 34)? How did this spiritual food cause Jesus to not need physical food at that moment? Can you relate to this? How can obedience to God's will become your food?

2. What did Jesus want His disciples to see (v. 35)? How does Jesus change how we see people?

3. What motivations did Jesus give His disciples to enter into the work of harvesting (vv. 36-38)? How is Jesus sending us to reap (v. 38) such a powerful motivation to work for Him? In what ways are you laboring in Jesus' harvest? In what ways can you labor even more in Jesus' harvest?

4. How did the Samaritans progress from relying on the woman's testimony to a more mature faith (vv. 39-42)? How is this pattern repeated in our lives and in the lives of those around us? How does this inform how we disciple others?
