**Discussion Questions** - These are a conversation starter and guide, not a script.

1. Paul begins this section by telling us that God is for us. In Romans 8:28-30, how can we be confident that God is for us? How might we start subtly thinking that God is not for us, but against us?

2. In v. 32, what evidence does Paul give the believer that God will give us all we need? What connection is there in this verse to what God told Abraham (Genesis 22:12)? Why is it so important that we remind ourselves that God will *graciously* give us all things?

3. What kind of confidence should the believer have according to vv. 33-34? How is Christ's resurrection the grounds for this confidence?

4. Why must we believe in the resurrection of Christ in order to answer Paul's question in v. 35? How does the love of Christ produce in us the confidence of v. 37?

5. Why is it so important that we be confident that not only Christ loves us, but that the Father also loves us? See vv. 38-39.
