Discussion Questions - These questions are a guide and a conversation starter, not an exact script.

1. What was the precise question that Boaz asked the foreman in v. 5? What was Boaz inquiring about? What was the ultimate answer to this question (see v. 12)?
2. In vv. 8-9, how did Boaz demonstrate his care for Ruth? Why was this so surprising?
3. In response to Ruth's question in v. 10, why did Boaz view Ruth with eyes of grace (vv. 11-12)? How does Boaz challenge us with regard to how we view others?
4. What significance was there in the Boaz's actions to Ruth during the mealtime in v. 14? Are there kinds of people you are naturally inclined to invite and not invite for a meal?
5. "All are welcome at church." How is this statement often taken too far? In what sense is this true? How does this passage, particularly vv. 11-12, inform us about who is welcome to be a part of God's people, no matter their past?
6. As believers in Christ, we are part of the family of God (Ephesians 2:19). Describe how a healthy family functions and treats one another. How can we as a church, and you as follower of Christ, live out our status as family members?
