(Is. 45:8, 2 Tim. 2:10)</p>	<p><b>2 GROWTH IN GRACE</b> I pray that they may “grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.” (2 Peter 3:18)</p>	<p><b>3 LOVE</b> Grant, Lord, that these children may learn to live a life of love through the Spirit who dwells in them. (Eph. 5:2, Gal. 5:22)</p>	<p><b>4 HONESTY &amp; INTEGRITY</b> May integrity and honesty be their virtue and their protection. (Ps. 25:21)</p>	<p><b>5 SELF-CONTROL</b> Father, help these children to be “alert and self-controlled” in all they do. (1 Thes. 5:6)</p>	<p><b>6 A LOVE FOR GOD’S WORD</b> May these children grow to find Your Word “more precious than gold, than much pure gold; [and] sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb.” (Ps. 19:10)</p>	<p><b>7 JUSTICE</b> God, help these children to love justice as You do and to “act justly” in all they do. (Ps. 11:7, Micah 6:8)</p>
<p><b>8 MERCY</b> May these children always “be merciful, as [their] Father is merciful.” (Luke 6:36)</p>	<p><b>9 RESPECT (for self, others, authority)</b> Father, grant that these children may “show proper respect to everyone,” as Your Word commands. (1 Peter 2:17)</p>	<p><b>10 STRONG, BIBLICAL SELF-ESTEEM</b> Help these children develop a strong self-esteem that is rooted in the realization that they are “God’s workmanship created in Christ Jesus” (Eph. 2:10)</p>	<p><b>11 FAITHFULNESS</b> “Let love and faithfulness never leave [these children],” but bind these twin virtues around their necks and write them on the tablet of their hearts. (Proverbs 3:3)</p>	<p><b>12 A PASSION FOR GOD</b> Lord, please instill in these children a soul with a craving for You, a heart that clings passionately to You. (Ps. 63:8)</p>	<p><b>13 RESPONSIBILITY</b> Grant that these children may learn responsibility, “for each one should carry his own load.” (Gal. 6:5)</p>	<p><b>14 KINDNESS</b> Lord, may these children “always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else.” (1 Thes. 5:15)</p>
<p><b>15 GENEROSITY</b> Grant that these children may “be generous and willing to share [and so] lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age.” (1 Tim. 6:18-19)</p>	<p><b>16 PEACE, PEACEABILITY</b> Father, let these children “make every effort to do what leads to peace.” (Rom. 14:19)</p>	<p><b>17 HOPE</b> May the God of hope grant that these children may overflow with hope and hopefulness by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Rom. 15:13)</p>	<p><b>18 PERSEVERANCE</b> Lord, teach these children perseverance in all they do, and help them especially to “run with perseverance the race marked out for [them].” (Heb. 12:1)</p>	<p><b>19 HUMILITY</b> Lord, please cultivate in these children the ability to “show true humility toward all.” (Titus 3:2)</p>	<p><b>20 COMPASSION</b> Lord, please clothe these children with the virtue of compassion. (Col. 3:12)</p>	<p><b>21 PRAYERFULNESS</b> Grant, Lord, that these children’s lives may be marked by prayerfulness, that they may learn to “pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests.” (Eph. 6:18)</p>
<p><b>22 CONTENTMENT</b> Father, teach these children “the secret of being content in any and every situation . . . through him who gives [them] strength.” (Phil. 4:12-13)</p>	<p><b>23 FAITH</b> I pray that faith will find root and grow in these children’s hearts, that by faith they may gain what has been promised to them. (Luke 17:5-6, Heb. 11:1-40)</p>	<p><b>24 A SERVANT HEART</b> Lord, please help these children develop servant hearts, that they may serve wholeheartedly “as if [they] were serving the Lord, not men.” (Eph. 6:7)</p>	<p><b>25 PURITY</b> “Create in [them] a pure heart, O God,” and let their purity of heart be shown in their actions.
