Treasurer's Notes and Analysis regarding 12/31/2023 Financial Statements

Since the end of October, 2023:

- 1) Revenues have increased by \$7.5K
- 2) Expenses have increased by \$12.5K, mostly in year-end disbursements for MTW activity.
- 3) Income decreased by \$5.0K for a year-end total of \$1.3K

The expense budget had \$10.3K remaining unspent, mostly in the Committee Operations accounts

Cash balance in the checking account is \$119.9K on 12/31/23 compared to \$129.9K on 10/31/23. Most of the change is due to a decrease of income and a gift made out of the Church Planting Fund by the MNA Committee to Advent Presbyterian Church.
