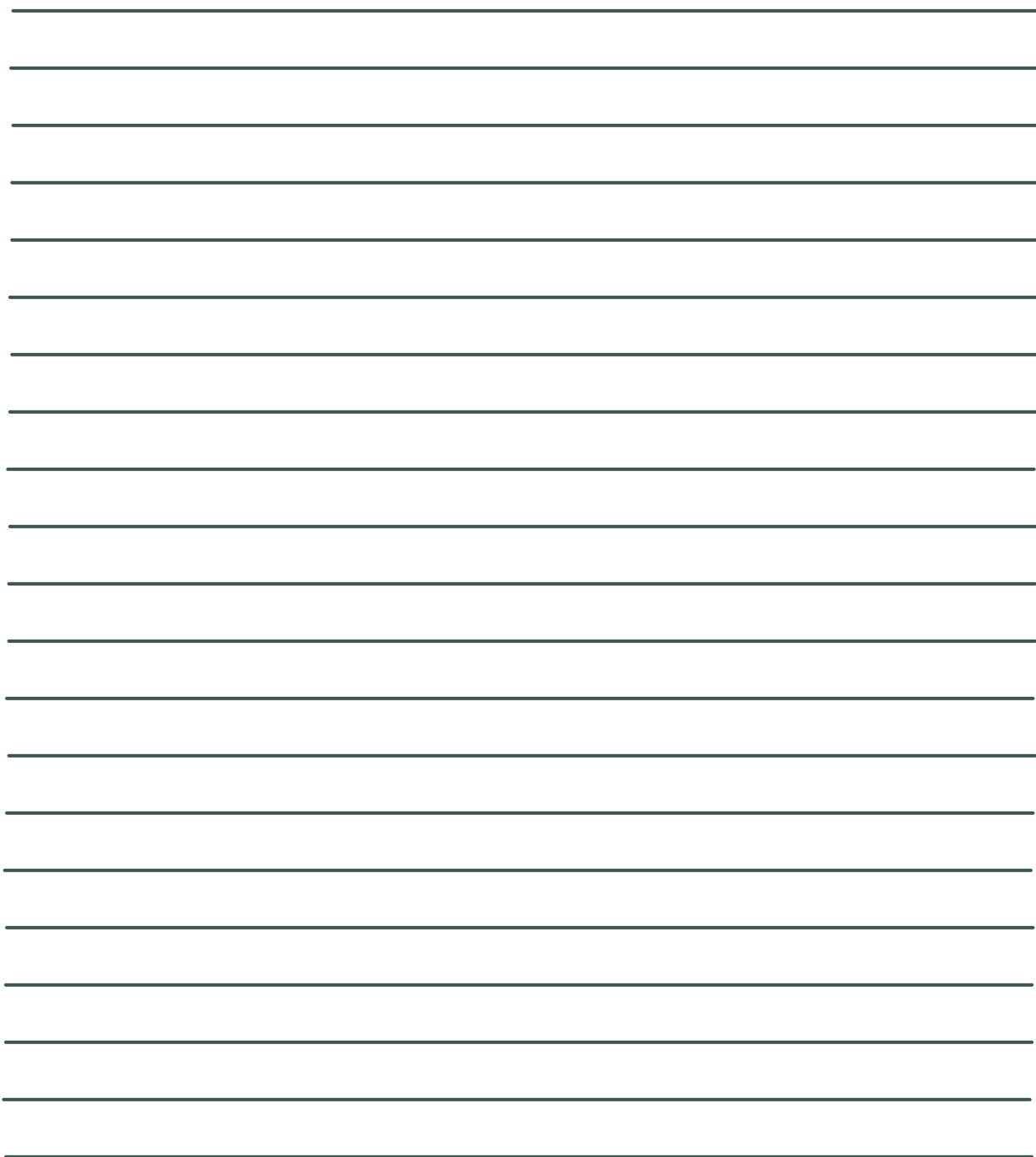
Preparing to Pray

Ecc 5:1-2 1 Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. To draw near to listen is better than to offer the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they are doing evil. 2 Be not rash with your mouth, nor let your heart be hasty to utter a word before God, for God is in heaven and you are on earth. Therefore let your words be few.

Eph 6:16-19 16 In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; 17 and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, 18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, 19 and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel,

Col 4:2-3 2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. 3 At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison—

Acts 12:1-12 ..."About that time Herod the king laid violent hands on some who belonged to the church. ...he proceeded to arrest Peter ...he put him in prison ...but earnest prayer for him was made to God by the church. ...And behold, an angel of the Lord stood next to him, and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him, saying 'Get up quickly.' And the chains fell off his hands. ...he went to the house of Mary ...where many were gathered together and were praying."



1. LCC Mission 2025 - The Ministry of the Word in the Information Age

- **Jn 4:23-24** 23 But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. 24 God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.”
- **Jn 8:31-32** 31 So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, 32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”
- **Josh 1:8** This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
- **Rom 12:2** 2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.
 - Dramatic Increase in Personal Bible Reading, Study, & Meditation
 - Testimonies of Renewed Minds and Increased Faith
 - Corporate Equipping (LCC would grow in equipping people to read their bibles well)
 - Leadership Depth (Present and future leaders would have depth in their biblical & systematic theology and ability to discern, defend and protect the truth in the midst of the Information Age)

2. Seasonal Awareness - Ecc. 3 Prayer Card: "What Time is it For You in 2025?"

- **1 Chr 12:32** Of Issachar, men who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, 200 chiefs, and all their kinsmen under their command.
 - Sunday Prayer Card
 - Faith, Favor, & Fight ...for the New thing God is Ordaining that you walk in

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3. Personal Stirrings & Awakenings ...stepping out in faith; taking risks

- **Acts 16:14** 14 One who heard us was a woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple goods, who was a worshiper of God. The Lord opened her heart to pay attention to what was said by Paul.
- **Is 6:8** 8 And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” Then I said, “Here I am! Send me.”
- **Ex 3:4, 10** 4 When the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.” ... 10 Come, I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring my people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.”
- **Ps 110:3** 3 Your people will offer themselves freely on the day of your power, in holy garments; from the womb of the morning, the dew of your youth will be yours.
- **Ex 31:1-3** 1 The LORD said to Moses, 2 “See, I have called by name Bezalel the son of Uri, son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, 3 and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with ability and intelligence, with knowledge and all craftsmanship,
- **Jer 20:9** If I say, “I will not mention him, or speak any more in his name,” there is in my heart as it were a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I am weary with holding it in, and I cannot.
- **Acts 6:5-6** 5 And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch. 6 These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands on them.

4. The Darkness of the Last Days

- **2 Tim 3:1-5** But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. 2 For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, 4 treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power...
- We pray and intercede in light of these attitudes and actions characterizing our day of advancing God's purpose
- **Matt 24:21** For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be.
- **Jn 16:33** I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."
- **Mk 16:15** "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation."
- New Orleans; America; the Western World; Global Missions; violence, injustice, oppression; natural mindedness, unbiblical churches, the proliferation of poor theology; cultural philosophy vs. sound doctrine
