Section 2 – Clarifying the covenant

- Chapters 4-11
 - 7:1-11 – judge(love)ment
 - 7:12-26 – if you listen & if you fear
 - 8:1-6 – the test of wanting

Deuteronomy 8:3 - *And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.*

- 8:7-20 – the test of wanting nothing
- 9:1-6 – it's not you, it's Him - **Gen 15:13-16**
- 9:7-26 – remember
 - rebellion
 - promise
- 10:1-11 – two new tablets
- 10:12-22 – fear – walk – love – serve - keep
- 11:1-32 – conclusion of love and worship

Commandment	Chapters in Deuteronomy and Exposition
1. No other gods	6–11, love and worship Yahweh
2. No idols	12–13, central sanctuary and false gods
3. Name	13–14, holiness to Yahweh
4. Sabbath	14–16, periodic duties
5. Parents	16–18, authority: judge, king, priest, and prophet
6. Murder	19–22, life and law
7. Adultery	22–23, regulations on sexuality
8. Theft	23–25, property
9. False testimony	24–25, truthfulness
10. Coveting	25, unselfish levirate marriage

Section 3 – Clarifying the commandments

- Chapters 12-26 (12-22:4)
 - 12 – 13 – Idols - altar law – no idols near or far
 - 13 - 14 – Name – worthless fellows – inquire

14:1 & 21 - “You are the sons of the Lord your God. ... For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. You shall not boil a young goat in its mother’s milk.”

- 14:22 – 16:17 – Sabbath – year by year – every 3 years – every 7 years – festivals
- 16:18 – 18 - Parents – Judges – Priests – Kings – Prophets

Deuteronomy 17:14-20 - “When you come to the land that the Lord your God is giving you, and you possess it and dwell in it and then say, ‘I will set a king over me, ... Only he must not acquire many horses for himself or cause the people to return to Egypt in order to acquire many horses... And he shall not acquire many wives for himself, lest his heart turn away, nor shall he acquire for himself excessive silver and gold.

And when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, he shall write for himself in a book a copy of this law, approved by the Levitical priests. And it shall be with him, and he shall read in it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the Lord

his God by keeping all the words of this law and these statutes, and doing them, that his heart may not be lifted up above his brothers, and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, either to the right hand or to the left, so that he may continue long in his kingdom, he and his children, in Israel.
