A little context—

*Why did Paul condemn making circumcision a **necessity** for salvation?*

The answer is found in the distinction between the O.T. and the N.T.

THE NECESSITY OF THE SHEDDING OF INNOCENT BLOOD
TO ATONE FOR THE SIN OF THE GUILTY
[2 Chron. 29:24]

Heb. 1:1—*God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in **many portions** and **in many ways**, 2 in these last days has spoken to us **in Son**...*

Heb. 10:1—*...the Law, [was] only a **shadow** of the good things to come and not the very **form** [image or likeness] of things to come...*

The Passover in **Ex. 12:22**—*Take a bunch of hyssops, dip it into the blood in the basin and put some of the blood on the top and on both sides of the doorframe... **Rev. 13:8***
