### Why Must We Suffer? – The Gift's Purpose

**1 Peter 4:12-13** Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. <sup>13</sup> But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.

- ⇒ To Cause us to Draw Near/Depend/Rely on his Strength
- **2 Corinthians 1:8-9** .... For we were so utterly burdened beyond our strength that we despaired of life itself. <sup>9</sup> Indeed, we felt that we had received the sentence of death. But that was to make us <u>rely not on ourselves</u> but on God who raises the dead.
- "Suffering is a gift because it reveals the insufficiency of everything but God."

- $\Rightarrow$  Pathway to Glory Those that have "Saving" Faith must Persevere till the End

## How to Suffer Well? – The Gift's Instructions

1 Peter 5:5-6 Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." <sup>6</sup> Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

### ⇒ Clothe "Put on" Humility – Christian Attire/Uniform (Colossians 3:12)

### Fear Not...Entrust your Soul – The Gift's Assurance

Isaiah 41:10

- **1 Peter 4:19** Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will <u>entrust their souls</u> to a faithful Creator while doing good. **1 Peter 2:23** ...when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued <u>entrusting himself</u> to him who judges justly.
- **1 Peter 5:10** And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.
