

ABOUT THE GO PROJECT

The Gospel is urgently needed!

With American culture becoming more and more hostile toward the things of God and the Christian church, there is an urgent need for the Gospel of Jesus Christ to be carried out from the church into our surrounding communities.

The EPC Presbytery of the East has answered the call.

Recognizing the need for the Gospel and the reality that most of our churches struggle to reach people with the Gospel, the Presbytery of the East has entered into a partnership with the GO Center to empower our churches to shift to a more outward focus in ministry that is centered on fulfilling the Great Commission.

HVPC is seizing the moment.

The partnership between the Presbytery of the East and the GO Center has placed resources and support for Great Commission ministry in our reach, and we are seizing the moment by joining in on the ground floor of the GO PROJECT. As part of the GO PROJECT Pilot, we will have direct access to all that the GO Center offers in the way of training, consulting and coaching, and will have the benefit of all that can be learned from other churches as they navigate this same terrain.

The ROADMAP is a proven process.

Our journey to revitalization and Great Commission impact in our community will be guided by the GO Center's ROADMAP to Missional Vitality. This ROADMAP includes Five Markers that will be reached over the course of 18-24 months: Marker 1 – Self-Discovery, Marker 2 – Motivation, Marker 3 – Skill-Training, Marker 4 – Implementation, Marker 5 – Evaluation. HVPC is already primed by having hosted GO Center training some months ago and taking a few first steps.

Dr. Ken Priddy is our personal guide.

Dr. Ken Priddy is the Founder and Executive Director of the GO Center and he is the creator of the core training curriculum of the GO PROJECT revitalization process. He will be HVPC's personal trainer, consultant and coach throughout the process, taking a hands-on role with the churches in the pilot.

The GO PROJECT requires a very reasonable financial investment.

To secure quality ministry of this type, churches are investing between \$30,000 - \$60,000. The GO Center is able to offer the GO PROJECT for \$15,000 as a standard fee, discounted for HVPC to \$12,500 due to the GO Center's partnership with the Presbytery of the East (POTE).
