Questions for Discussion

- 1. Try to describe, in your own words, the main point of this sermon.
- 2. Is it wrong for us to desire glory? Is it inherently selfish to desire that the good that we do will be noticed and appreciated? Is *God* selfish for desiring glory?
- 3. Do you think that whether a person desires to be noticed and appreciated depends on people's personalities and temperaments? Or do you think that everyone desires such recognition? Why?
- 4. What does "you shall have no other gods before me" *mean*? In what ways do we bring other gods before God? Why is this insulting to God? Why is it bad for *us*?
- 5. When Luther says that we never break commandments 2-10 without also breaking commandment number 1, what does he mean? Can you describe a time when this has been true for you?
- 6. Are God's "smoke and thunder" and God's "smoke and smiles" in competition with one another? Does one "outweigh" the other? Why or why not?
- 7. What is the summary of the 10 Commandments? What is the summary of the *summary*? What does this *mean*?
- 8. What would change in your life if you treasured God's glory?
- 9. What is God saying to you? What are you going to do about it? Who is going to help you?
