Here is our suggestion for how to use this resource with your children:

- Read the Bible story and then watch the children's message together.
- Discuss the Attribute of God.
- Print a coloring or activity page related to the Bible story (below) for your child. There is also a link to a craft.
- Read or recite the memory verse together each day of the coming week.

Bible Story: Zacchaeus Luke 19:1-9

Zacchaeus the Tax Collector

19 Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. ² A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy. ³ He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd. ⁴ So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.

⁵ When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." ⁶ So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.

⁷ All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."

⁸ But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."

⁹ Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham.

Memory Verse - I Timothy 6:17






Zacchaeus Meets Jesus
