Leader: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.

People: Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.
For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned, and done what is evil in your sight, so that you are justified in your sentence and blameless when you pass judgment.
Leader: You desire truth in the inward being; therefore teach me wisdom in my secret heart. Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.
People: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence, and do not take your holy

Assurance of God's Pardon

Leader: The Lord says, "I will sprinkle clean water upon you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. **People: A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; and** I will remove from your body the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws." (Ezekiel 36:25-26)

God's Will for Our Lives

Leader: Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation—but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it.

People: For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

Leader: For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. **People: The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."** (Romans 8:12-15)
