Swiss Payment Changes

Switzerland is changing their payment process from payment slips to QR codes starting October 1. For most of us on the bill paying side, there is nothing to be done but use the new codes sent to us. However, if you have set up a standing order to donate money to IPC using a payment slip or just the account number (not the IBAN), the standing order will no longer be processed.
