## *Earnestly I seek you...*

The primary passage for the teaching during our retreat will be Philippians 3:10, “**that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being confirmed to His death.**”

Group discussions will focus on Psalm 63 and in particular what David means in Psalm 63:1, “O God, you are my God, **earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you**, in a dry and weary land where there is no water.”

Some questions to think about and discuss are:

- As our world is being shaken and we are facing unimaginable horror - **how might knowing Christ now help us** as we seek to bring hope to the people around us?
- How would knowing Christ more **alleviate the fear and anxiety** that has become an epidemic in the church and our society?
- What difference will **the truth we have heard today** make to your own life?
- Do you have an experience you might share of **a time when the Lord has brought joy and peace into your heart** amidst a stressful or difficult situation?
