1 Be **THANKFUL** for the goodness of God that has redeemed you 

*For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9***

*knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot. **1 Peter 1:18-19***

2 Move with **CONFIDENCE** into the future He's calling you to 

*To this end we always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and may fulfill every resolve for good and every work of faith by his power, **2 Thessalonians 1:11***

*And the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will Himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. **1 Peter 5:10*** 



3 Take up **COURAGE** to navigate the tests awaiting you

*Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. **James 1:2-4***

4 Stick with **CONSTANCY** to the course laid out before you

5 Enjoy with **CONTENTMENT** the rewards that come your way
