The BACKGROUND

2 Kings 4:8-17

•A wealthy woman from Shunem provides a room for Elisha whenever he comes through the area.

•Elisha wishes to reward this woman for her hospitality, so he promises that she will have a son in one year. This all takes place as Elisha says.

2 Kings 4:18-21

•God answered her hidden desire to be a mom.
•In the midst of her heart's desire the unspeakable happens.

The WOMAN'S HEARTACHE

•While working with his dad, the son has either heatstroke or an aneurysm.
•The illness was short-lived. By noon he was dead.
•She did something uncommon: instead of going into hysteria and planning his funeral, she laid him on the bed of the man of God.

The WOMAN NEEDS AN ANSWER

2 Kings 4:22-28

•The woman asked for a donkey and a servant to make the 15 mile trek as fast as possible. As she leaves she says, "All is well."

•She ran and caught hold of Elisha's feet. And she said, "Did I ask my lord for a son?"—"Did I not say, "Do not deceive me?"
•The woman says, "As the Lord lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you."
•She is convinced that Elisha—God's servant is the answer to her pressing need.

Elisha's RESPONSE

Elisha sends his servant, Gehazi with instructions to lay the staff on the child's face.

Gehazi went on ahead and laid the staff on the face of the child, but there was no sound or sign of life. Therefore he returned to meet him and told him, "The child has not awakened." 2 Kings 4:31

The WOMAN'S FAITH IS INTACT

The woman is not giving up. She is not calling for mourners. She is determined that God who gave her the miracle child has the final word.

Elisha follows up: *Then he went up and lay on the child, putting his mouth on his mouth, his eyes on his eyes, and his hands on his hands. And as he stretched himself upon him, the flesh of the child became warm. Then he got up again and walked once back and forth in the house, and went up and stretched himself upon him. The child sneezed seven times, and the child opened his eyes. 2 Kings 4:34-35*
