He asked the one in the wrong, "Why are you hitting your fellow Hebrew?" 14 The man said, "Who made you ruler and judge over us? Are you thinking of killing me as you killed the Egyptian?" • Exodus 2:11-15

- Had been miraculously adopted into the family of Pharoah.
- Was being prepared to become Egypt's ruler.
- Had acquired incredible influence in the courts of Egypt.
- Took matters into his own hands and killed an Egyptian soldier while protecting an Israelite.
