CHANGE THE FUTURE BY OWNING *THE PAST*

²⁴ At a lodging place on the way, the Lord met Moses and was about to kill him. ²⁵ But Zipporah took a flint knife, cut off her son's foreskin and touched Moses' feet with it. "Surely you are a bridegroom of blood to me," she said. ²⁶ So the Lord let him alone. (At that time she said "bridegroom of blood," referring to circumcision.)

* MOSES RETURNS TO EGYPT *

Exodus 4:24-26

- Leaves with his father-in-law's blessing.
- Returns with the LORD's assurance.
- Returns with his family.
- · Goes with the staff of God.

A MAKE-OR-BREAK ENCOUNTER

- On the way to Egypt, God confronts Moses.
- It's a "threshold" moment
- Moses has failed to keep the sign of the covenant.
- Zipporah, his wife, stepped up and circumcised their son.

◆ THE SIGN OF COVENANT ◆

Circumcision was the mark of covenant. Moses and Zipporah

had not followed through with that act of faith.

11 You are to undergo circumcision, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and you. 12 For the generations to come every male among you who is eight days old must be circumcised, including those born in your household or bought with money from a foreigner—those who are not your offspring. 13 Whether born in your household or bought with your money, they must be circumcised. My covenant in your flesh is

to be an everlasting covenant. ¹⁴ Any uncircumcised male, who has not been circumcised in the flesh, will be cut off from his people; he has broken my covenant."



◆ BAGGAGE FROM THE PAST ◆

"The greatest betrayal in life is settling for what you can have today over what you really want." —Boyd Parker

- Moses has lived in two very different cultures.
- Each of those cultures had expectations, values, and traditions.
- He is being called to a very old culture.
 The culture of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
 Moses is trapped until he can disconnect
- That culture also had expectations, values and traditions.
- Moses brings baggage from his past attempting to live it out in this old "faith" culture. It does not work.
 - Moses is trapped until he can disconnect from his past and be released to obey God's demands.

HE NEEDS TO OWN UP TO HIS STUFF!

◆ WHY THE ENCOUNTER? ◆

- To bring Moses to a place of alignment with God.
- Is he a covenant person? Will he mark his household as covenant people?
- How can he lead covenant people if he himself is not keeping the covenant?

◆ A NEW SEASON ◆

- Zipporah is a hero.
- She took a small step of faith that opened up a future.
- She saved the lives of Moses and her son.
