THE VISION

Genesis 37:3-5

³ Now Israel loved Joseph more than any of his other sons, because he had been born to him in his old age; and he made an ornate robe for him. ⁴ When his brothers saw that their father loved him more than any of them, they hated him and could not speak a kind word to him. ⁵ Joseph had a dream, and when he told it to his brothers, they hated him all the more.

¹⁰ When he told his father as well as his brothers, his father rebuked him and said, "What is this dream you had? Will your mother and I and your brothers actually come and bow down to the ground before you?" ¹¹ His brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept the matter in mind.

THE OPPOSITION

Vs 12: Goes to find his brothers **Vs 20:** They plot to kill him
Vs 23: They throw him in the pit **Vs 28:** They sell him into slavery
Vs 31: They deceive their father

THE TEASERS

38:36 Sold to Potiphar in Egypt **39:2** God was with him - prospered
39:7-19 Potiphar's wife - prison **20** God was with him - granted favor
Ch.40 Baker/Cupbearer - forgotten **Ch.41** Pharaoh - remembered

THE FULFILLMENT

41:41 He gains authority over everything, a wife and two sons

Ch.42-44 His brothers come to Egypt needing food

THE CHOICE

- * He accepts where he is
- * He makes the best of it
- * He ignores temptation
- * He trusts again and again
- * He does not seek payback
- * He hides his emotions
- * He reveals his identity
- * He embraces/kisses them
- * He acknowledges God
- * His family reaps from his blessing
- * He receives his father's blessing
- * His sons receive his father's blessing

THE MORAL OF THE STORY

- God does not operate on man's time but he is always on time
- Sometimes those closest to you are the biggest hindrance
 - Don't mistake the teaser as the vision
