MEMORY TRIGGERS

“ We need to be reminded more than instructed. –C.S. Lewis ”

◎ THE UNFORGIVING DEBTOR ◎

Matthew 18:21-35

- ◎ A servant owes his master ten thousand talents and begs for patience. (18:23-26)
- ◎ The master forgave this servant his debt. (18:27)
- ◎ This forgiven servant is then approached by a fellow servant who owed him a small amount of money and begged for patience. (18:28-29)
- ◎ This forgiven servant refused to forgive this small debt and had the man imprisoned. (18:30)
- ◎ When the master learned of this forgiven servant's actions, he revoked the forgiveness he had extended, and demanded that he pay all. (18:31-34)
- ◎ That is what our heavenly father will do to us if we do not, from the heart, forgive our brothers. (18:35)

Check out the short lapse of time. What it reveals is this: What God did for him never made the transition from SHORT-TERM MEMORY into LONG-TERM MEMORY. And the lesson was lost on him. He didn't connect the dots. The problem: an unsanctified memory.

We tend to remember what we should forget and forget what we should remember. And our lack of memory leads to bad behavior. In the case of the unforgiving debtor? He forgot God's grace so he acted ungracefully.

WHY MEMORY?

- We have a difficult time internalizing or personalizing the lessons God is trying to teach us.
- The truth gets into our short-term memory, but it doesn't make it into our long-term memory.
- So we have to relearn the same lesson all over again. We've been following Christ for seventeen years, but we don't have seventeen years of experience.
- We have one year of experience repeated seventeen times.
- Memory enables us to pick up where we left off.

MEMORY TRIGGERS

⁵ and said to them, “Go over before the ark of the Lord your God into the middle of the Jordan. Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, ⁶ to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, ‘What do these stones mean?’⁷ tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it crossed the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever.”

————— *Joshua 4:5-7* —————

- God uses a “memorial” as a memory trigger.
- He tells Israel: “Use this as a generational sign—it’s a testimony.”
- Use sight and sound to perpetuate the goodness of God.
- Build altars. Take communion. Keep the memory alive.
- God wants to sanctify our memory—to flow short-term memory to long-term memory.
- He wants to “seal” the deal!
