Three Instructions



Israel must follow the Ark of the Covenant as soon as they see it is being moved.

At the end of three days the officers went through the camp and commanded the people, "As soon as you see the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God being carried by the Levitical priests, then you shall set out from your place and follow it. Joshua 3:2-3

- · The Ark of the Covenant is God's throne on earth.
- · God will be leading Israel into the Promised Land.
- · God is still the undisputed King and Sovereign of Israel.



Israel must keep a space of 2,000 cubits (1,000 yards)

Yet there shall be a distance between you and it, about 2,000 cubits in length. Do not come near it, in order that you may know the way you shall go, for you have not passed this way before. Joshua 3:4

- · The Ark of the Covenant must be visible to everyone.
- · Those that are following must be focused on the Ark.
- · God intended for Israel to breach the Jordan with Him! But it could only be done if they focused on and followed Him.



Israel must consecrate themselves.

Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." Joshua 3:5

- The Hebrew word for consecrate means "to prepare, to dedicate, to be hallowed, to be holy, to be separate or set apart."
- · Personal repentance of every known sin.
- · Spiritual alert: expecting God to move.

The Step — of Faith

The Lord said to Joshua, "Today I will begin to exalt you in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with

Moses, so I will be with you. And as for you, command the priests who bear the ark of the covenant, 'When you come to the brink of the waters of the Jordan, you shall stand still in the Jordan.'" Joshua 3:7-8

We will never cross the river unless we take that step of faith.

And when the soles of the feet of the priests bearing the ark of the Lord, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan shall be cut off from flowing, and the waters coming down from above shall stand in one heap. Joshua 3:13
