In Luke 10:25-37, Jesus is “put to the test” by a lawyer seeking to inherit eternal life. Jesus asks him how he reads the Law, which was, after all, his profession. The answer is to love God with one’s whole heart, soul, strength, and mind.

Jesus answers with a parable. The parable describes a man, probably presumed to be a Jew by the Jewish audience, on a dangerous 18-mile stretch of road leaving Jerusalem. **He falls among robbers, is stripped, beaten, and left on the road.**

1 A PRIEST PASSES BY HIM

A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. **Luke 10:31**


2 A LEVITE GOES AROUND HIM

So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. **Luke 10:32**

3 A SAMARITAN HAD MERCY ON HIM

But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper. ‘Look after him,’ he said, ‘and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.’


Jesus drives home the point to the lawyer through storytelling about who a good neighbor is: the one who shows mercy. That is what the representing Jesus and his kingdom is all about.

Representing Jesus and His Kingdom displays:


> COMPASSION

- Takes care of the injured man's wounds.
 - Focuses on the injured man's needs.
 - Protects him from further violence.
 - Tends to him as though he was a brother.
 - Takes him to an inn. Pays the innkeeper.
- 

> SELFLESSNESS

- Takes care of the injured man's wounds.
 - Uses his own supplies.
 - Transports him on his own donkey.
 - Takes him to an inn. Pays the innkeeper.
 - Does not put a limit on the money needed to nurse him back to health.
- 

> GENEROSITY

- The Samaritan uses his own resources.
 - Does not "lend" his supplies. Freely gives them away.
 - Does not put a money limit on what he will do for the injured man.
 - His approach: "Whatever it takes—I'll pay the price!"

- Nonperishable food.

- Toothpaste, toothbrushes, lip balm, & floss.
- Feminine Hygiene Products.
- Small & large bottles of shampoo, conditioner, lotion, body wash.
- Black hair care products: shampoo, conditioner, oil sheen, pomade/grease, edge control.
- Sandwich (zip lock & fold bags) & quart size zip lock bags.
- Toilet bowl cleaner, bleach, HE powder laundry detergent.
- Toilet paper, paper towels, facial tissue.
- Basic Office Supplies: copy paper, envelopes, pens, highlighters, notepads, paper clips, tape.
- Plastic or reusable grocery bags for the food pantry.
