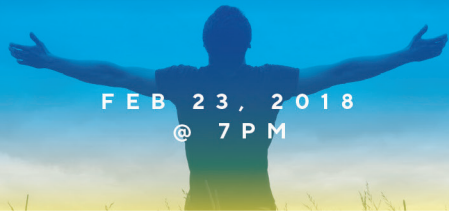

<sup>5</sup> So he came to a town in Samaria called Sychar, near the plot of ground Jacob had given to his son Joseph. <sup>6</sup> Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about noon. <sup>7</sup> When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?" <sup>8</sup> (His disciples had gone into the town to buy food.) <sup>9</sup> The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.) <sup>10</sup> Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water. **John 4:5-10**

## High noon at Jacob's Well

Jesus and His followers are walking home to Galilee; they are tired and the road is dusty. Jesus would simply like a drink of water. He is at a local landmark known as Jacob's well, but He does not have a bucket. Buckets were not left at public wells;

buckets were earthen jars, and were carried with you when you traveled. **Jesus has no means to get the water, and so He waits for someone to come.** The well is in an area called Samaria, and so it is a Samaritan woman who approaches Him with a water jar.

### Conversations



It's odd that Jesus would engage her in conversation for a number of reasons:



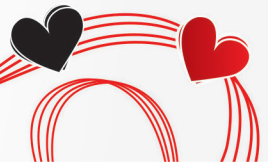
1 Jews weren't supposed to speak to Samaritans.



2 Men weren't permitted to address women without their husbands present.



3 Rabbis had no business speaking to shady ladies such as this one.





## What is recorded is the longest conversation that Jesus had with anyone in the gospels.

- ♥ They talk about water and being thirsty.
- ♥ They talk about their common history. (descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob) and the religious hostility between their peoples (each group thinks that they have the true understanding about God).
- ♥ They talk about her personal journey with 5 husbands, there have been many broken relationships in her life.
- ♥ They talk about where God can be found—is it on this holy mountain or that holy mountain in Jerusalem?
- ♥ And how do we truly worship God? How do we express our love for God?

## Some Observations

- ♥ She was religiously poisoned.
- ♥ She was racially prejudiced.
- ♥ She was acting as if she had something to offer.
- ♥ Jesus stopped her: "Where is your husband?"
- ♥ "He's not exactly my husband—he's my friend."
- ♥ One of the characteristics of being dissatisfied is running from person to person.

## Jesus Makes a Bold Statement

*Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water." John 10:10*
