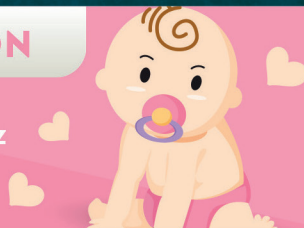

The **BAPTISM** of the Holy Spirit



Jesus used the terminology

For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” *Acts 1:5*



John the Baptist introduced the term



The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!” *John 1:29*

³²Then John gave this testimony: “I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. ³³And I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.’” ³⁴I have seen and I testify that this is God’s Chosen One.” *John 1:32-34*

The **MEANING** of Baptized



Comes from the Greek word, baptizo, which means “to dip”. It describes a process of complete submersion. This is not a casual sprinkling. Jesus comes to immerse us in the Holy Spirit. It is an infilling—an outpouring that leads to overflowing.

The **MANIFESTATION** at *Pentecost*

1. They spoke with other tongues.
2. Preaching with revelatory insight into God's word.
3. The love of God became manifest in their lives.
4. Miracles began and continued.

The *Fountain*/satisfies the thirst within

¹³ Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, ¹⁴ but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life." *John 4:13-14*



The *Rivers*/serve the need of others

³⁷ On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. ³⁸ Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them." *John 7:37-38*

The **STORY** of *Cornelius* (*Acts 10*)



OBEDIENCE/WANTING GOD'S WILL (*Acts 10:2*)

- Cornelius had a heart for God
- He was ready to obey Him.



HUMILITY/WANTING GOD'S WAY (*Acts 10:33*)

- Cornelius humbly accepted Peter and his word.
- He was teachable wanting to be in right standing.
- He had an unqualified desire for God's way.
- He was pure in his motives.



RECEIVING/WANTING GOD'S FULLNESS (*Acts 10:47*)

- They received the Holy Spirit before they were baptized in water.
- Their hunger for God was incredible.
