## Big Idea:

Fulfillment of the promise requires radical obedience.

## Renewing the covenant

As Joshua prepares to lead Israel across the Jordan River and into the Promised Land, steps are taken to renew the covenant with the Lord. Two of the significant features of the covenant are reinstituted:

### **▶** Circumcision **▶** I

Passover

At that time the LORD said to Joshua, "Make flint knives for yourself, and circumcise the sons of Israel again the second time."

Joshua 5:2

While the people of Israel were encamped at Gilgal, they kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month in the evening on the plains of Jericho. Joshua 5:10

Joshua:

"We've had 40 years of living out 'what doesn't work'. Let's go back to 'what does work'.

# The Passover story



"These are your instructions for eating this meal: Be fully dressed, wear your sandals, and carry your walking stick in your hand. Eat the meal with urgency, for this is the Lord's Passover. On that night I will pass through the land of Egypt and strike down every firstborn son and firstborn male animal in the land of Egypt. I will execute judgment against all the gods of Egypt, for I am the Lord! But the blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign, marking the houses where you are staying. When I see the blood, I will pass over you. This plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt." Exodus 12:11-13

# Marked people

In Equador there is a tribe known as the Colorado Tribe. now know as Tsachila Indians. but the Spanish referred to them as "Colorado" which means "red", a name chosen because the men of the tribe shave their hair off at the sides with the remaining hair sculpted with the use of a mixture of grease and

red achiote seeds into a pointed peak cap-like shape.

In Israel they were marked through circumcision and observance of the Passover. Both were signs of obedience as well as signs of marking. In short—Israel was God's covenant people.

# The blood of sprinkling

In Exodus 12 the blood of sprinkling meant preservation. The LORD was executing judgment against all the gods of Egypt through the plagues that were unleashed by Moses and Aaron.



Blood Frogs Lice or gnats Locusts Darkness Death of the firstborn Livestock -



God's covenant people were spared—here's what it says:

- 1. You shall take a lamb for a household, Exodus 12:3
- 2. The lamb shall be a year old: unblemished. Exodus 12:5
- 3. At the assigned time the whole assembly shall kill the lambs at twilight. Exodus 12:6
- 4. They were to take the blood and put it on the doorposts. Exodus 12:7
