There is a difference between
your **destiny** and your
destination.

Destination

A place which is the goal of a journey or to which something is sent (The journey)

Destiny

A future that someone or something will have (The purpose)

There is also a difference
between **fate** and **destiny.**

Fate implies that there is a lack of control or inevitability.
(No choice)

Destiny suggests that there is a sense of direction/influence.
(Choice)

**Our destination is either heaven or hell.
Our fate was condemnation.**

Our destiny is God's purpose for our lives. It is our ordained future. It is what God has ordained us to become!

Through our union with Christ, we have been claimed as His own. Before we were even born, He gave us our destiny to fulfill the plan of God.

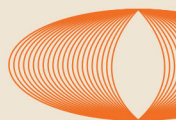
