Background

Conflict was in the air: the Pharisees had learned that Jesus was making and baptizing more

disciples than John. (John 4) To the Pharisees this was not a good omen. Sensing hostility, Jesus left and went to Galilee.

One on one with a ·

. *Samaritan* Woman

And he had to pass through Samaria. So he came to a town of Samaria called Sychar, near the field that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. Jacob's well was there; so Jesus, wearied as he was from his journey, was sitting beside the well. It was about the sixth hour. A woman from Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give me a drink." (For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.) The Samaritan woman said to him, "How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria?" (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.) John 4:4-9

- · Jesus was sitting at Jacob's well at midday.
- · Jesus needed water.
- · She marvels that he engages her.

A conversation for the ages

John 4:10-15

- Jesus asks for a drink
- She counters: "How is it that you a Jew ask to use my cup?"
- Jesus raises the stakes: "I have Living Water."

- She tells him he has no bucket or rope...and asks if he is greater than Jacob.
- Jesus assures her that anyone that drinks from the well will thirst again, but the water he gives will quench the thirst forever.
- She says: "give me this water."

SHE HAD PLENTY OF REASONS NOT TO EVER RETURN TO JACOB'S WELL.

Reasons *Jesus* went to Sychar

To begin the work of reconciliation in Israel

And he had to pass through Samaria. John 4:4

- · The Jews and Samaritans were enemies.
- · Each believed the other had denied the faith.
- · The Jews believed: one God; one book; one Torah; one Mt. Zion.
- · The Samaritans believed: one God; one book; one Torah; one Mt. Gerizim.

To reveal himself as the Messiah •••

The woman said to him, "I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things." Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am he." John 4:25-26

- · She had already asked if he was greater than her father Jacob.
- · She is aware that Messiah was expected and that he is the deliverer and restorer of all things.
- · Jesus self-identifies. He tells her He is the Messiah.

To graciously offer this woman The Kingdom

Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father. You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews. John 4:21-22

- · Jesus came to this out-of-the-way place to show her God's plan.
- Jesus tells her that pathway is not Mt. Gerizim, Mt. Zion, but Mt. Spirit and Truth
- · His motive is not to destroy but to deliver.
