There are five purposes that we were created by God to fulfill: worship, unselfish fellowship, spiritual maturity, our ministry, and our mission.

*(The Purpose Driven Life, by Rick Warren)*

*We were planned for God's pleasure – to know him and love him;*

*We were formed for God's family – to find a home and family;*

3

*We were created to become like Christ – with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self control;*

*We were shaped for serving God – with a unique mix of talents, skills and passion; and*

5

*We were made for a mission – to introduce other people to God's five purposes for their lives too.*

**Without a God-given purpose to shape our life, we become driven by destructive influences because we are all motivated by something.**



**Guilt, fear, anger, resentment, wealth, materialism, titles, revenge, competition, etc.**



**Knowing our God-given purpose gives meaning to our life, simplifies our life, focuses our life, motivates our life, and prepares us for eternity!**
