▶ EASTER MIRACLE

Vaughn Fitzgerald, Rodney's brother, had an accident that caused him to have a brain bleed. He ended up in emergency surgery in Miami Hospital, Toledo Ohio. The surgeon did not give the family much hope. The surgeon said, "We did our job well, but the rapid and complete recovery is simply a miracle!"

DON'T STOP, NOW!

Tucked away in 2 Kings 13, there is a compelling account for the power of persistence:

And he said, "Take the arrows," and he took them. And he said to the king of Israel, "Strike the ground with them." And he struck three times and stopped. Then the man of God was angry with him and said, "You should have struck five or six times; then you would have struck down Syria until you had made an end of it, but now you will strike down Syria only three times."

The backstory

1. THESE WERE DESPERATE TIMES:

Elisha had become sick with a terminal illness.
King Joash would have one less counselor.
Syria was increasingly hostile to Israel.

And Elisha said to him, "Take a bow and arrows." So he took a bow and arrows. Then he said to the king of Israel, "Draw the bow," and he drew it. And Elisha laid his hands on the king's hands. And he said, "Open the window eastward," and he opened it. Then Elisha said, "Shoot," and he shot. And he said, "The Lord's arrow of victory, the arrow of victory over Syria! For you shall fight the Syrians in Aphek until you have made an end of them." 2 Kings 13:15-17

INSTRUCTION BY MEANS OF SYMBOLIC ACTIONS:

2. "Take a bow and arrow...open the window—shoot!"
"Go outside...strike the ground."
King Joash struck the ground 3 times.
