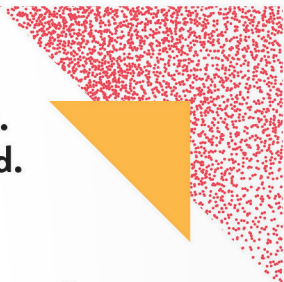


What is required of stewards is that they be found faithful.

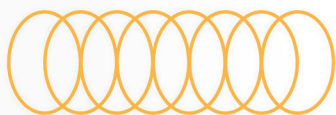
