#### The Promise of Power

Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

#### OMNIPOTÉNCE

means all-powerful. God has supreme power. This means God can do what he wants. It means he is not subject to physical limitations like man is. Being omnipotent, God has power over wind, water, gravity, physics, etc.

Three Greek words are translated "power" in Scripture—exousia ("authority"), dunamis ("ability"), and kratos ("strength") Galatians 5:22

This word, indicative of might, strength, force, is used in the Old Testament in numerous instances being varied in the) to words like "valor," "rule," "strength," "might," "dominion."

We see this in creation, the many miracles and prophecies.

Matthew 28:18 "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, 'All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth."

We see this in his miracles, deliverances, and defeating death at the cross.

He tells us that this power was promised to the disciples. Jesus final words to his followers: Luke 24:49 "I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

15 ut you will teteive pow on non: and non mill be mi These words are then repeated: Acts 1:4-9 "On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with he Holy Spirit." Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight."

Acts 2:38b-39 "And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call."

The majority of attendees struggle with life's issues which may include but are not limited to, anger, loneliness, broken relationships, a general sense that something is wrong, divorce, loss of loved one, loss of a job, issues that are symptoms of being an adult child.
