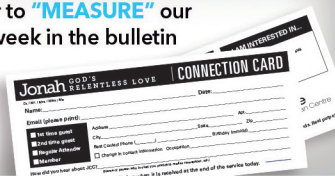

Jarvis found an outlet to memorialize her mother by working to promote a day that would honor all mothers... this is how Mother's Day got started.

- Let me "live the big life."



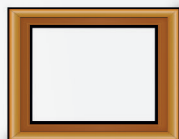
2 *Laugh Often*

The Harriet Tubman Story



- Born a slave around 1822 (Minty Ross).
- She learned values from her mother Rit.
- One day, the slave owner stopped by their cabin to take one of the boys to sell him. Rit told him that if he came in she would take his head off—he believed her and left them alone.
- In 1849 Minty escaped to the North and took on a new name.
- During her lifetime she helped 70 families escape from slavery to freedom in the underground railroad.
- There always came a point for those had been slaves: they would long for the familiar.
- Harriett would pull out a pistol and tell them: “You will go to freedom or you will die—but you will not turn back.”
She was willing to love them hard!
