¹⁴ For this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the Lord sends rain on the land." ¹⁵ She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. 1 Kings 17:14-15



THE STORY LINE —

- Llijah was being fed by ravens at the brook, Cherith.
- When the brook dried up and the ravens failed to show, God gave him a new instruction to go to Zarephath, a small village in Zidon.
- * There, a widow would receive an instruction to provide food for them.
- **☆** When he arrived at the widow's, the scene was dismal and tragic. She was gathering wood for a last meal. Her son lay emaciated on his deathbed in her little house.



A PICTURE OF HER FUTURE

- Her supply had run out. She had no faith for survival.
- The instructions of the man of God were outrageous: "Take one of those biscuits and give it to me."
- * Elijah's instructions are life-giving. His instructions are seeds. He was sowing them toward the widow. "Would you go get some water for me? While you're at it, would you bring me a meal?"
- The widow replied: "I can't do that. I don't have enough. Just enough for me and my son. Elijah explained patiently,"I understand that you're wise to take care of your son, but first..."
- He suddenly gave her a miracle reason for sowing. He showed her a picture of a future—something she hadn't noticed. He revealed to her that something she already had in her possession was the key to getting into her future. He gave her a picture of the potential supply—the harvest!

THE KEY IDEA:


When you empty your present, God promises to fill your future!
