— There are several life-giving principles in the Book of Ruth I'm focusing on one life-giving principle:

"Your future is determined by who you listen to."

Boaz — **Ruth 2:8** *offer of care and protection*

"Then Boaz said to Ruth, "You will listen my daughter, will you not? Do not go to glean in another field, nor go from here, but stay close by my young women. Let your eyes be on the field which they reap, and go after them. Have I not commanded the young men not to touch you? And when you are thirsty, go to the vessels and drink from what the young men have drawn."

Boaz — **Ruth 2:14** *mealtime invitation*

"Now Boaz said to her at mealtime, "Come here, and eat of the bread, and dip your piece of bread in the vinegar."

Naomi — **Ruth 2:22** *place yourself in Boaz' path*

"Now Boaz said to her at mealtime, "Come here, and eat of the bread, and dip your piece of bread in the vinegar."

Naomi — **Ruth 3:1-3** *pre-engagement signal*

"Then Naomi her mother-in-law said to her, "My daughter, shall I not seek security for you, that it may be well with you? Now Boaz, whose young women you were with, is he not our relative? In fact, he is winnowing barley tonight at the threshing floor. _____

Therefore wash yourself and anoint yourself, put on your best garment and go down to the threshing floor; but do not make yourself known to the man until he has finished eating and drinking. Then it shall be, when he lies down, that you shall notice the place where he lies; and you shall go in, uncover his feet, and lie down, and he will tell you what you should do."

Boaz — **Ruth 3:13** *I'm interested...*

“Stay this night, and in the morning it shall be that if he will perform the duty of a close relative for you—good; let him do it. But if he does not want to perform the duty for you, then I will perform the duty for you, as the LORD lives! Lie down until morning.”

Boaz — **Ruth 3:15** *the first Sam's Club*

“Also he said, “Bring the shawl that is on you and hold it.” And when she held it, he measure six *ephahs* of barley, and laid it on her. Then she went into the city.”

Naomi — **Ruth 3:18** *wait to be redeemed*

“Then she said, “Sit still, my daughter, until you know how the matter will turn out; for the man will not rest until he has concluded the matter this day.”

One process. Seven instructions, four from Boaz, three from Naomi. Ruth was wanting a second chance; a new beginning. Crucial to her success was her ability to listen.

— **Two unlikely people had what she needed for her future: her mother-in-law who had experienced calamitous losses; and a Jewish farmer who was not the most likely bachelor and probably not on the cover of GQ.**

Ruth listened. Prayerfully, patiently and obediently. And her dark night turned into the choicest outcome!

“Then the women said to Naomi “Blessed be the LORD, who has not left you this day without a close relative; and may his name be famous in Israel! And may he be to you a restorer of life and a nourisher of your old age; for your daughter-in-law, who loves you, who is better to you than seven sons, has borne him.” *Ruth 4:14-15*
