# FATHERHOOD



God is known by many names: *Elohim* (Supreme); *Yaweh* (the LORD); *El Elyon* (God Most High); *El Shaddai* (God Almighty); *Jehovah-Jireh* (The Lord will Provide); *Jehovah-Nissi* (The Lord our Banner); *Jehovah-Rapha* (The Lord who Heals You); *Jehovah-Shalom* (The Lord our Peace). But He was never addressed as **“ABBA, FATHER”** until Jesus was in the Garden of Gethsemane. In using this expression Jesus spoke as a child would speak to its father. This reflects something of the intimacy and trust that characterized His relationship with God.

**“ABBA, FATHER,”** he said, “everything is possible for you. Take this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will.” *Mark 14:36*



- Abba is an informal Aramaic term for Father, connoting intimacy, tenderness, dependence, and complete lack of fear or anxiety. Modern English equivalents would be Daddy, or Papa.
- Jesus transformed the relationship with God from a distant, corporate experience into an intimate, one-to-one bond.
- He taught His disciples to pray with the same intimacy. And that is what He does for us. The way we are to pray is **“Our Father” — “Our Abba” — “Our Dearest Father”**.



In the New Testament Paul reiterates this same concept:

<sup>17</sup>Therefore, “Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you.” <sup>18</sup>And, “I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.

*1 Cor. 6:17-18*



**JESUS IS THE INITIATOR OF AN INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY UNAVAILABLE.**

But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights (v. 4) of sons (“*fully adopted children*”). Because you are sons (“*fully adopted children*”), God sent the Spirit of his (*natural born*) Son Jesus into your hearts, the Spirit who calls out, (*from within you*) “Abba, Father.” So you are no longer a slave, but a son (“*fully adopted child*”); and since you are a son (“*fully adopted child*”), God has made you also a full heir (v. 7). *Galatians 4:4-7*

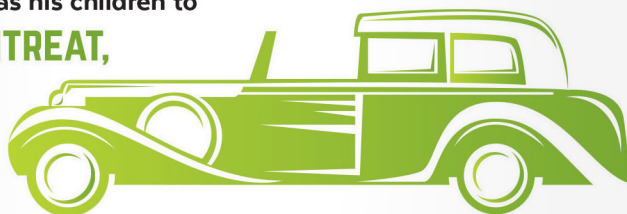
