* FATHER'S DAY * TAKING THE HIGH ROAD

3 He came to the sheep pens along the way; a cave was there, and Saul went in to relieve himself. David and his men were far back in the cave. 4 The men said, "This is the day the LORD spoke of when he said to you, 'I will give your enemy into your hands for you to deal with as you wish." Then David crept up unnoticed and cut off a corner of Saul's robe. 5 Afterward, David was conscience-stricken for having cut off a corner of his robe. 6 He said to his men, "The LORD forbid that I should do such a thing to my master, the LORD's anointed, or lay my hand on him; for he is the anointed of the LORD." With these words David sharply rebuked his men and did not allow them to attack Saul. And Saul left the cave and went his way. 1 Samuel 24:3-&

- ★King Saul was jealous of David's bravery and popularity.
- **★** David was forced to become a fugitive in the wilderness of Judea training a band of guerillas.
- **★**Saul was working overtime to find David—and kill him.
- **★** Saul closed in on David (unknowingly) and David had the opportunity to kill Saul but chose not to.
- ★Instead, he cut off a piece of his robe and later was conscience-stricken for it.

HE CUT OFF THE KING'S GARMENT AND WRESTLED WITH GUILT

Then David crept up unnoticed and cut off a corner of Saul's robe. 1 Samuel 24:4 He said to his men, "The LORD forbid that I should do such a thing to my master, the LORD's anointed, or lay my hand on him; for he is the anointed of the LORD." 1 Samuel 24:6



HE DECLARED A RIGHTEOUS PRINCIPLE

With these words David sharply rebuked his men and did not allow them to attack Saul. And Saul left the cave and went his way. 1 Samuel 24:7
