Moses my servant is dead. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel. Joshua 1:2 ESV

Something had to end so
that something new could begin—

- Moses' death signaled the end of an era.
- His death was a shattering event.
- The people loved him, revered him and treasured him.
- His passing was the catalyst for something new.
- It wasn't until Moses crossed over from this world to the next that the people of God would cross over the Jordan River.

What does crossing over look like?

It's a journey of **FAITH**

- Joshua along with Caleb were spies that gave a "good report" of the land. Numbers 33
- They believed that with God's help they could conquer it. Joshua 1
- He embraced God's promise that they literally would step off the boundaries of their Promised Land. Joshua 1

OBEDIENCE

- Joshua assumed command. Instructed the people to prepare to take possession of the land. Joshua 1
- Joshua sent spies to Jericho on a reconnaissance mission. Joshua 2
- Joshua brought the people to a crossover point known as Acacia Grove. Joshua 3
- He gave them instructions for a new season. They were to follow the Ark. Joshua 3

CONSECRATION

The framework

Then Joshua said to the people, *“Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you.”* And Joshua said to the priests, *“Take up the ark of the covenant and pass on before the people.”* So they took up the ark of the covenant and went before the people.” **Joshua 3:5-6**

Profile of Joshua ✨

Moses' second-in-command:

- Was a man without a pedigree.
- He was a man without the proper experience or credentials for what would unfold.
- He was not specially trained, competent or qualified.
- God chose him and filled him with the strength necessary to lead.
- The victory or victories would come from God's strength—not his.

Undergirding advice

 *Be strong and courageous, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you.* **Joshua 1:6-7**
