DEBORAH

From Shade-Tree Prophetess to Side-Kick Soldier

Barak said to her, "If you go with me, I will go. But if you do not go with me, I will not go." *Judges 4:8*

Then Deborah said to Barak, "Now is the time for action! The Lord leads on! He has already delivered Sisera into your hand!" Judges 4:14



BACKGROUND

- Israel was being terrorized by King Jabin and his 900 chariots of iron.
 - Workers murdered on the job
 - Women dishonored
 - Crops destroyed
 - Children murdered at play
- Discouraged, many Israelites had returned to idols.
- Even for the faithful the tabernacle had been neglected in favor of backyard altars.
- Plans for conquering the land had been abandoned.
- Cooperation among the tribes was at an all time low.



MESSAGE FROM GOD

"The Lord God of Israel has commanded you to mobilize ten thousand men from the tribes of Naphtali and Zebulun. Lead them to Mount Tabor to fight King Jabin's mighty army with all his chariots, under General Sisera's command. The Lord says, 'I will draw them to the Kishon River, and you will defeat them there.'

THE BATTLE

And Deborah said to Barak, Up! For this is the day when the Lord has given Sisera into your hand. Is not the Lord gone out before you? So Barak went down from Mount Tabor with 10,000 men following him.

And the Lord confused and terrified Sisera and all his chariot drivers and all his army before Barak with the sword. And Sisera alighted from his chariot and fled on foot.

But Barak pursued after the chariots and the army to Harosheth-hagoiim, and all the army of Sisera fell by the sword; not a man was left.

But Sisera fled on foot to the tent of Jael, the wife of Heber the Kenite, for there was peace between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite. (AMP)

THE FINAL NAIL

But Jael, Heber's wife, took a tent pin and a hammer in her hand and went softly to him and drove the pin through his temple and into the ground; for he was in a deep sleep from weariness. So he died.
