The Sun **Stands Still**

After Israel crossed the mighty Jordan River, there were a series of victories that taught them that God was for them and not against them.

As Israel's army became more and more feared, five kings united to overtake Gibeon because Gibeon had made peace with the people of God.

- Once again, the Lord went before them.
- Before a single battle was fought, God threw the enemy into a panic and more enemy soldiers were killed by mysterious hailstones that fell from heaven than were killed with the sword.

*As they fled before Israel on the road down from Beth Horon to Azekah, the Lord hurled large hailstones down on them, and more of them died from the hail than were killed by the swords of the Israelites. **Joshua 10:11***



Joshua's Crazy-Big Request

*On the day the Lord gave the Amorites over to Israel, Joshua said to the Lord in the presence of Israel: "Sun, stand still over Gibeon, and you, moon, over the Valley of Aijalon." So the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, till the nation avenged itself on its enemies, as it is written in the Book of Jashar. The sun stopped in the middle of the sky and delayed going down about a full day. **Joshua 10:12-13***

bend to the power of the living God.*
