GOD IS MY FUTURE

Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Psalm 23:6

Daviol knew God as a shepherd, as a restorer, as a guide, as a healer, and as the God of his tomorrows. He is confident of his future. He has experienced God at so many levels that he is convinced that the best is yet to come. The story of Abraham shows us that we can trust God with our tomorrows.

The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. *Genesis 12:1*

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would laterreceive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. *Heb. 11:8*

"Give me your tomorrows. Live the rest of your life putting your future into my hands, one day at a time. Commit your life to a promise: I will bless you, guide you and lead you to a place that you never imagined."

Abraham is a PATTERN MAN

He is an example or model for us to "pattern" after. We are to live our lives patterned after him. He is known as the Father of Faith. The apostle Paul tells us that all who believe and trust in Christ are the children of Abraham.

³¹ So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' ³² For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. ³³ But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. ³⁴ Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. *Matthew* 6:31-34

Only God Can Redeem YOUR YESTERDAYS

GOD IS MY FUTURE

Highlights of ABRAHAM'S LIFE

- 1. He was born and raised in Ur of the Chaldees, a city located in the land of Mesopotamia

 Gen. 11:27-29; Acts 7:2-4
- 2. Prior to his conversion, Abram was a worshiper of idols *Josh. 24:2* God appeared to him, and Abram became a believer *Acts 7:2*
- 3. He was commanded by God to leave Mesopotamia for a new land that God had promised to show him at age 75. *Gen.* 12:1; Acts 7:3
- 4. He receives a seven-fold promise from God *Gen.* 12:2-3
- 5. He arrives in Canaan, is promised the land by God, and builds an altar at Bethel *Gen.* 12:5-9
- 6. He goes to Egypt during a famine in Canaan, and lies about his wife Sarai. *Gen.* 12:10-20
- 7. He returns to Bethel and again worships God *Gen.* 13:4
- 8. He separates from his nephew Lot after an argument over land grazing rights *Gen. 13:5-13*
- 9. God again promises to give him the land of Canaan *Gen.* 13:14-17
- 10. He moves to Hebron and builds an altar to God *Gen.* 13:18
- 11. He is promised a son and to become the father of a great nation *Gen.* 15:1-5
- 12. He believes God and is declared righteous due to his faith *Gen.* 15:6

13. He enters into a blood covenant with God *Gen.* 15:7-11

14. In a dream God reveals to him that his descendants would serve in a foreign land for 400 years, but then

depart with great substance Gen. 15:12-17

15. He is now given the boundaries of the land.

Gen. 15:18-21

16. At the advice of his barren wife Sarai, he marries Hagar, her Egyptian handmaid with the hope that he could father a son through her *Gen.* 16:1-3

17. Soon after conception, and following an argument, Hagar is sent to the desert by an angry Sarai.

Gen. 16:4-6

18. God appears to Abram when he was 99 years old and changes his name to Abraham *Gen.* 17:1-5
19. He again is promised both seed and soil.

Gen. 17:6-8

20. Abraham is visited by the Lord and two angels, who again reassure him of Isaac's birth, now to occur in less than a year *Gen.* 18:1-15

21. He moves to Philistia and, as he had once done in Egypt, lies about his wife *Gen. 20:1-2*

22. Isaac is born when Abraham was 100 years old *Gen. 21:1-8*

23. He offers up Isaac on Mt. Moriah at God's command *Gen.* 22:1-10

24. He is ordered to kill a ram

in place of Isaac. Gen. 22:11-13

25. He calls the name of that place Jehovah-jireh *Gen. 22:14*

26. The Abrahamic Covenant is now reconfirmed. *Gen.* 22:15-19
