God Has a Good Plan for Me During Suffering



*For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart. **Jeremiah 29:11-13***

The Context *Context*

In the Old Testament, because of sin and division, God's people were divided into two kingdoms, The Northern Kingdom (*Israel*) and the Southern Kingdom (*Judah*).

- Both of these kingdoms were sinking into idolatry and immorality.
- God sent prophets to both kingdoms to warn them of coming judgment.
- Assyria captured Israel and took people captive.

The Judah Story *Story*

- For forty years Jeremiah warned of impending judgment.
- In 587 B.C. Babylon overtook Jerusalem, and many people were taken captive to Babylon.
- People were scattered throughout Babylon and

experienced all kinds of suffering.

- There were false prophets who were trying to comfort God's people by saying:



*For thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are among you deceive you, and do not listen to the dreams that they dream, for it is a lie that they are prophesying to you in my name; I did not send them, declares the Lord. **Jeremiah 29:8-9***

God's instruction *For thus says the Lord: When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will visit you, and I will fulfill to you my promise and bring you back to this place. Jeremiah 29:10*

[Get comfortable—you're going to be in exile for a while]

3 Promises to God's People

1 I will bring you through your suffering

I will be found by you, declares the Lord, and I will restore your fortunes and gather you from all the nations and all the places where I have driven you, declares the Lord, and I will bring you back to the place from which I sent you into exile. Jeremiah 29:14

2 I will hear your prayers to me

Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. Jeremiah 29:12

3 I will reward your pursuit of Me

You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart. Jeremiah 29:13

**Suffering is a reality for God's people.
God promises to walk with His people through suffering.**

God's Plan Hinges *God's* on One Person

- Jesus is the resurrected Prophet from Jonah.
- Jesus is the faithful Husband from Hosea who doesn't give up on His people.
- Jesus is the Burden-Bearer from Amos.
- Jesus is the Restorer from Joel.
- Jesus is the Prince of Peace in Isaiah.
- Jesus is the Everlasting Ruler from Micah.
- Jesus is the Covenant-Keeper from Jeremiah.
