≡ WILDERNESS THINKING ≡

1. Wilderness thinking limits God due to our unbelief.
2. Wilderness thinking finds expression through complaining.
3. Wilderness thinking negotiates and blames God and others.
4. Wilderness thinking leads to death (*99% of that generation died in the wilderness*).
5. Wilderness thinking prevents us from reaching our true potential.



If you turn away from following him, he will again leave all this people in the wilderness, and you will be the cause of their destruction. *Numbers 32:15*
