# A Wrong View Of God

- Leads us to believe that we are a disappointment to God and deserve his anger.
- Is not based on a biblical view of God motivating people to fear that God is angry with us.
- Prompts us to think that God is critical, condemning and judgmental—that He is on edge about our behavior.
- This kind of thinking causes us to believe that God is focusing on what we do wrong, instead of what we do right.
- Causes us to think that we have "crossed the line"—that we are too far gone for God to love us.
