Surround Sound - Praise 2 Chronicles 20:1-26



These verses relate a story in which there was the real possibility that Israel would face extinction. Jehoshaphat feared as he realized the multitude had gathered against them. It appeared that the

enemy marching on them would surely destroy them.

- · Jehoshaphat was afraid.
- · 2 Chronicles 20:3 tells us that when Jehoshaphat became afraid, he "turned his attention to the Lord" and prayed.
- What makes the difference is what the person does in the face of fear.

Sometimes God allows impossible problems into our lives in order to move 🗼 🎍 us to a place of surrender.

JEHOSHAPHAT'S

· Jehoshaphat sought the Lord with a fast.

Response

· His earnest prayer led to a word from the Lord via the Holy Spirit who spoke

it to Jahaziel, who in turn spoke encouragement to the people as a prophet.

The battle is the Lord's. 10MORROW...watch the Lord move.



The problem led to prayer which brought prophetic hope.

Jehoshaphat DEFINES THE ISSUE

- · He recognized that the problem wasn't the forces coming at them, but the spiritual forces behind the troops.
- · He took a spiritual approach to a spiritual problem. The people came together confronting a physical reality with a spiritual dynamic.

Expressions of PRAISE

¹⁸ And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground; the inhabitants of Ierusalem bowed before the Lord, worshiping the Lord. SHACHAH

19 Then the Levites of the children of the Kohathites and of the children of the Korahites stood up to praise the Lord HALAL God of Israel with voices loud SHABACH

and high.

²¹ And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who should sing to the Lord, and who should praise HAIAI the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army and were saying: "Praise, the Lord, For His mercy endures forever. 2 Chronicles 20:18-19: 21

· Praise is not limited to the physical realm. Praise works across the physical and penetrates spiritual strongholds.
