Things I've Learned About God

God Has a Plan Even When I Don't Know What to Do

Grace Gives More

No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him. **1 Corinthians 2:9 (NLT)**

When you were younger, you were asked, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" What kind of answer did you give? Are you living out that early dream now?

King Jehoshaphat - 2 Chronicles 17: 3-6

The Lord was with Jehoshaphat because he walked in the first ways of his father [David]. He did not seek the Baals But sought and yearned with all his desire for the Lord, the God of his father, and walked in His commandments and not after the ways of Israel. Therefore the Lord established the kingdom in his hand; and all Judah brought tribute to Jehoshaphat, and he had great riches and honor. His heart was cheered and his courage was high in the ways of the Lord; moreover, he took away the high places and the Asherim out of Judah.

Judah gets Invaded - 2 Chronicles 20: 1-2

After this, the Moabites, the Ammonites, and with them the Meunites came against Jehoshaphat to battle. It was told Jehoshaphat, A great multitude has come against you from beyond the [Dead] Sea, from Edom; and behold they are in Hazazon-tamar, which is En-gedi.

Jehoshaphat's Prayer 2 Chronicles 20:5 - 13

"... We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on You".

Jehoshaphat's immediate response was to seek the Lord. Faced with the threat of battle, he proclaimed a fast, bringing the people of Judah together to seek help from God. This highlights the importance of **turning to our spiritual foundation when confronted with challenges beyond our control.**

Jahaziel and the Spirit of the Lord 2 Chronicles 20: 14 – 19

You shall not need to fight in this battle; take your positions, stand still, and see the deliverance of the Lord [Who is] with you, O Judah and Jerusalem. Fear not nor be dismayed. Tomorrow go out against them, for the Lord is with you.

Jehoshaphat's Battle Plan and Secret to Victory 2 Chronicles 20: 20 – 26

When he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers to sing to the Lord and praise Him in their holy [priestly] garments as they went out before the army, saying, Give thanks to the Lord, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever! And when they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushments against the men of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir who had come against Judah, and they were [self-] slaughtered;

With no hope in sight and enemies closing in, Jehoshaphat turns to a surprising weapon... Praise! Instead of relying on military might, he gathers his people to worship, leading them into battle with songs and music instead of swords and shields. **PRAISE IS A WEAPON!**

BACK TO THE *First* QUESTION...

Instead of, "what do you want to be...", ask yourself, "who do you want to serve?" This changes everything! Jehoshaphat could have said I want to be King and be rich, etc., but instead, he served the Lord and took care of the people in his stead. Ask yourself that same question in this new light... Everything will fall into place when our eyes are set on the Lord.

When life seems hopeless and you are lost and unsure of the next step, that is when it is time to pray and praise. God's Mercy and Grace will be your supply and lead you THROUGH your troubles. We don't know what to do, but God, our eyes are on YOU! Amen and let it be!
