

SOME WRONG THINKING ABOUT FORGIVENESS

There is something deeply embedded in the human psyche that resists God's offer of complete forgiveness. We utter protests that only stifle our faith with thoughts like:

- I have sinned a whole lot—not just a little.
- I am just not a good person.
- I can't get my act together.
- Doubts come easier than faith to me.
- I'm just not there yet.
 (righteous)

This kind of thinking leads to wrong assumptions—there is no way I can ever come totally clean; there will always be some residue in me; I might as well live with those markings of my past.

GOD'S PERSPECTIVE: MAN NEEDS A SAVIOR

He made Christ who knew no sin to [judicially] be sin on our behalf, so that in Him we would become the righteousness of God [that is, we would be made acceptable to Him and placed in a right relationship with Him by His gracious lovingkindness]. 2 Corinthians 5:21 AMP



GOD'S PROVISION: THE BLOOD OF JESUS

1. SALVATION: In Salvation God Rescues Us

We are released from sin and guilt—EXPIATION

Otherwise Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But he has appeared once for all at the culmination of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. *Hebrews* 9:26

We are cleared from God's wrath—PROPITIATION

²⁴ and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. ²⁵ God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished— *Romans 3:24-25*

We are restored to fellowship with God—RECONCILED

that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. *2 Corinthians* 5:19

We are set free from bondage—REDEEMED

¹⁸ For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, ¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. 1 Peter 1:18-19

2. REVELATION: In Revelation God Discloses Himself



¹⁵ The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. ¹⁶ For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. ¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. *Colossians 1:15-17*

3. CONQUEST: In Conquest God Triumphs Over Evil

And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross. *Colossians 2:15*



And such were some of you [before you believed]. But you were washed [by the atoning sacrifice of Christ], you were sanctified [set apart for God, and made holy], you were justified [declared free of guilt] in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the [Holy] Spirit of our God [the source of the believer's new life and changed behavior]. 1 Corinthians 6:11 AMP
