

## Flip the Curse

As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today.

So do not fear; I will provide for you and your little ones." Thus he comforted them and spoke kindly to them. **Genesis 50:20-22** 

- · Joseph was the 11 th of 12 sons.
- · He was his dad's favorite.
- · His older brothers were his half-brothers.
- This created great conflict in the family.
- · Joseph was oblivious to the conflict.

## A little about Joseph

- His brothers sold him for 20 pieces of silver.
- He was taken to Egypt—sold as a common slave.

Joseph endured thirteen years of pain and suffering, including a false accusation that landed him in prison. Through all the injustice, he didn't play the victim.

His enslavement and imprisonment were blessings in disguise.

What did Toseph do to his brothers who sold him as a slave?
He didn't curse them. Instead he blessed them.

How did Joseph flip the curse?

1 He built a godly reputation before he was betrayed

From the time that he made him overseer in his house and over all that he had, the Lord blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; the blessing of the Lord was on all that he had, in house and field. So he left all that he had in Joseph's charge, and because of him he had no concern about anything but the food he ate. Genesis 39:5-6

#### 2 He did not respond when his emotions were high

Whoever is slow to anger has great understanding, but he who has a hasty temper exalts folly. Proverbs 14:29

## 3 He relinquished the right to revenge

And Joseph said to his brothers, "I am Joseph! Is my father still alive?" But his brothers could not answer him, for they were dismayed at his presence. So Joseph said to his brothers, "Come near to me, please." And they came near. And he said, "I am your brother, Joseph, whom you sold into Egypt. Genesis 45:3-4

Then he fell upon his brother Benjamin's neck and wept, and Benjamin wept upon his neck. And he kissed all his brothers and wept upon them. After that his brothers talked with him. Genesis 45:14-15

#### 4) He trusted God with his future and didn't look back

And God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant on earth, and to keep alive for you many survivors. So it was not you who sent me here, but God. He has made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house and ruler over all the land of Egypt. Hurry and go up to my father and say to him, 'Thus says your son Joseph, God has made me lord of all Egypt. Come down to me; do not tarry. Genesis 45:7-9

Joseph became a source of blessing: God leveraged his pain, time, talent, and treasure so that lives would be saved!

And as you have been a byword of cursing among the nations, O house of Judah and house of Israel, so will I save you, and you shall be a blessing. Fear not, but let your hands be strong. **Zechariah 8:13**
